

PROCEDURE FOR FIELD USAGE

PIATELLI FIELD

• PRIOR TO THE START OF THE GAME

1. REMOVE TARPS IF THEY ARE OVER THE BASE AREAS, PITCHERS MOUND & HOME PLATE AREA FOLD AND PLACE IN THE CORNER OF THE FIRST BASE DUGOUT ALONG WITH SPIKES.
2. RAKE AROUND BASES, PITCHERS MOUND & HOME PLATE AREA.
3. REMOVE PLUGS FROM BASE INSERTS AND PLACE BASES.
4. IF SCOREBOARD WILL BE IN USE, ASSIST WITH SETUP OF TABLE AND SCOREBOARD CONTROLLER.
5. IF YOU HAVE A GAME UNDER THE LIGHTS? THE KEY IS AT THE SNACK BAR, ONLY TURN ON THE BASEBALL FIELD SWITCH AND NOT UNTIL 7:15. MAKE SURE YOU LOCK THE SWITCH BOX AFTER YOU TURN ON LIGHTS SO THE OTHER SWITCHES DON'T GET TURNED ON BY MISTAKE.

AFTER THE GAME IS OVER

1. BOTH TEAMS SHOULD WORK TOGETHER.
2. REMOVE THE BASES AND PUT IN PLUGS. BASES GO IN SHED ON THE SECOND SHELF ABOVE THE LIGHT SWITCHES.
3. DRAG ENTIRE INFIELD USING DRAG RAKE.
4. PLACE TARPS OVER BASE AREAS (SQUARE TARPS), HOME PLATE AREA (LARGE ROUND TARP) & PITCHERS MOUND (SMALL ROUND TARP) USING THE SPIKES TO SECURE ALL TARPS (UNLESS YOU ARE SURE THAT THERE IS NO RAIN IN THE FORECAST)
5. BRAKE DOWN SCORERS TABLE AND PUT AWAY WITH CHAIRS AND SCOREBOARD CONTROLLER BACK IN SHED.
6. IF THE LIGHTS HAVE BEEN ON? SHUT OFF THE SWITCH AND LOCK THE BOX UP.
